AZALEA

Shrub : Deciduous + Semi/Evergreen

Syn. Rhododendron. Named varieties of dwarf evergreen hybrids. There is a huge range of these April and May flowering evergreen and semi-evergreen dwarf shrubs. They vary in height when mature from around 60cm to about twice that. They need moist (not waterlogged) lime-free soil, protection from wind and will thrive in light shade. The colour range embraces white, a host of pink and red shades, mauves and purples.

BERBERIS

Shrub : Deciduous + Evergreen

The 'Barberries' are very useful, mainly spring flowering, deciduous or evergreen shrubs ranging from restrained dwarfs at less than 1m to very vigorous tall spreaders at 3m plus. Most varieties have colourful berries and the deciduous types have good autumn leaf colour. Berberis thrive in virtually any position, in sun or shade. Most make good hedges.
