CARPINUS Tree : Deciduous

- **betulus**. *The Hornbeam is a shade tolerant, relatively slow growing but ultimately medium-tall tree. The trunk has smooth grey bark which often has prominent ribs. The foliage is ovate and toothed with an uneven surface. When used as a hedge the brown autumn foliage persists all winter. Best in well-drained, fairly rich conditions, but can thrive in chalky, sandy or dry soil. Root-balling is recommended at 12-14cm girth & upwards.*

- pungens Maculata . <i>Vigorous medium sized evergreen shrub. Foliage boldly marked with a central blotch of bright yellow.</i>

EUONYMUS			Shrub : Deciduous + Evergreen		
<i>This valuable genus contains some of the best amenity shrubs. They are incredibly variable ranging from dwarf or medium evergreens and climbers to deciduous small trees. They thrive in sun or shade and in virtually any soil. The flowers are relatively insignificant.</i>					
- japonicus Ovatus Aureus . <i>Foliage margined with yellow. Good in shade but brighter in sun.</i>

Shrub : Evergreen

- **heterophyllus**. *Evergreen foliage resembling, but smaller than, Holly. Slow growing rounded bush up to 1.8 metres. Fragrant white flowers in autumn.*

- **fraseri Red Robin**. *Vigorous evergreen shrub with rich red young foliage which ages to glossy green.*

PLATANUS

Tree : Deciduous

- **acerifolia**. *Syn. hispanica or hybrida. The London Plane is a vigorous tall tree with a broad, irregular crown. Because it can stand heavy pruning and atmospheric pollution it is widely used in town squares and streets. The foliage is palmate and large, the bark a patchwork of various shades of green, fawn and grey. Needs well-drained soil. Not recommended for cold exposed sites.*

Conifer Tree + Shrub : Evergreen

- **baccata**. *The Yew is a native evergreen conifer of slow growth, ultimately a tree. Very useful for hedging. Will grow in virtually any well-drained soil. Seeds are poisonous.*

Tree : Deciduous

- **cordata Green Spire**. *Fast growing, tidy, medium sized tree with a relatively narrow upright habit; with age the pyramidal crown becomes more rounded. Foliage larger than cordata. Good street tree for a wide range of conditions.*

- **x euchlora**. *This large growing hybrid Lime has a conical, rather narrow head. With advancing age the lower branches tend to droop. Nevertheless this is an excellent street tree as it does not drip the aphid honeydew which can be a nuisance to car owners. Twigs green, foliage normally ovate, shining rich green above, much paler below.*
